



## Spectacular Summer Canadian Maritimes Tour Itinerary

### ➤ Mon, Aug. 19

Meet your tour director and depart on your 12-day Maritime Tour. Today you will travel to Levis, QC, and stop for lunch and rest breaks along the way.

**Overnight:** Hampton Inn & Suites by Hilton Quebec City/Saint-Romuald

### ➤ Tue, Aug. 20 (B & D)

Arrive and check into the Holiday Inn Express Fredericton (or similar) in Fredericton, NB. After check-in, freshen up in your room before we head out and enjoy an included dinner at a local restaurant. The remainder of the evening is at your leisure following dinner.

### ➤ Wed, Aug. 21 (B & L)

Check out of the hotel and travel to the Bay of Fundy to walk the ocean floor at Hopewell Rocks. The Bay of Fundy is home to the highest tides in the world. Enjoy an included lunch at High Tides Café. This afternoon you will depart for Halifax. Along the way a stop will be made at the Anne Murray Centre in Springhill, NS. The centre showcases the incredible life and times of Springhill's internationally acclaimed songstress Anne Murray. This evening you will arrive in Halifax and check in to Hampton Inn Halifax (or similar). This evening is free to explore the downtown area and to enjoy dinner at a local restaurant (not included).

**Overnight:** Holiday Inn Halifax

### ➤ Thu, Aug. 22 (B)

This morning you will meet a Local Step-on Guide and travel to Lunenburg and Peggy's Cove. Highlights will include a Marine-Life Boat Tour, as well as free time to explore Lunenburg and Peggy's Cove. Return to Halifax later this afternoon. The remainder of the day is free to explore the city and have dinner (not included) at one of the many restaurants in downtown Halifax.

### ➤ Fri, Aug. 23 (B & D)

This morning you will meet a Local Step-on Guide for a tour of Halifax. During this tour a stop will be made at Fairview Lawn Cemetery where over 100 victims of the Titanic are buried. Later this morning you will also visit the Maritime Museum of the Atlantic. This afternoon you will visit the Halifax Seaport Farmers' Market for lunch (not included). After lunch we have a visit to Pier 21, Canada's Immigration Museum. This evening, after free time to explore the downtown area, get together for dinner at a local restaurant. The remainder of the evening is at your leisure.

**Overnight:** Holiday Inn Halifax

### ➤ Sat, Aug. 24 (B & D)

Check out of the hotel and drive to Sydney, Cape Breton. A visit to the community of Antigonish will be made for lunch, as well as a visit to the Peace By Chocolate shop. Check into hotel. This evening, join your group for an old-fashioned Cape Breton Ceilidh and dinner.

**Overnight:** Auberge Gisele's Baddeck

### ➤ Sun, Aug. 25 (B & L)

Check out of the hotel and meet a Local Step-on Guide who will share the rich history of Cape Breton as you tour the Cabot Trail. A stop will be made along the trail for an included lunch. Following the tour, you will stop for dinner (not included) in Antigonish before continuing to Stellarton, NS.

**Overnight:** Holiday Inn Express Stellarton-New Glasgow

### ➤ Mon, Aug. 26 (B & D)

After checking out of the hotel you will begin your journey to Prince Edward Island. You will board the Northumberland Ferry in Caribou, NS, for a 75-min sail across the Northumberland Strait to Wood Islands, PE. Arrive in Charlottetown early this afternoon, you will have free time to explore the downtown. Later you will check in to the hotel and have time to freshen up before dinner. Following dinner, you will attend Anne of Green Gables the Musical.

**Overnight:** Rodd Royalty Hotel

### ➤ Tue, Aug. 27 (B & D)

This morning you will meet a Local Step-on Guide for a full-day tour of Prince Edward Island. You will travel to Cavendish, where highlights include a visit to Green Gables Heritage Place and a drive through the Prince Edward Island National Park. Next, you head to North Rustico where you will learn about the important role the fishing industry plays on the Island. You will also visit the Prince Edward Island Preserve Company where you can browse the tastefully decorated gift shop. This evening you will be treated to a traditional lobster dinner at Fisherman's Wharf Lobster Suppers in Rustico. Return to Charlottetown.

**Overnight:** Rodd Royalty Hotel

### ➤ Wed, Aug. 28 (B)

Check out of the hotel and begin making our way back to New Brunswick. Prior to departing Prince Edward Island, a visit will be made at a PEI Potato Farm. You will cross the Confederation Bridge and make our way to Edmundston with a stop for lunch. This evening arrive in Edmundston, NB, and check in hotel. Explore the area on your own.

### ➤ Thu, Aug. 29 (B, D)

Check out and travel to Quebec City, QC. Start exploring this Quebec City historic guided tour. This tour, including a mixture of walking and being on the bus, will teach you the history of the only North American fortified city north of Mexico whose walls still exist. Quebec City was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1985, as the "Historic District of Old Québec." We will board our coach and visit the Basilica of Saint-Anne-de-Beaupre, a church credited with many miracles of curing the sick and disabled. We will also make a photo stop at Montmorency Falls before returning to Old Quebec. Check into hotel. This evening we have our Farewell Dinner.

**Overnight:** Best Western Plus Quebec City

### ➤ Fri, Aug. 30 (B)

Check out of our hotel and make our way back home.
